Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines to the CUD community for conducting research involving humans.

Scope

This policy applies to all the CUD community who are involved in research involving humans.

Policy Statement

CUD is legally and morally committed to ensure that research activities involving humans conducted in its name meet all ethical standards and policies.

As a research institution, for any research that involve human subjects, CUD is committed to ensure that all research associated with the University fully complies with the UAE laws and guidelines established by the TRI COUNCIL POLICY; the Medical Research Centre (MRC), the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC), and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada (SSHRC), as stipulated in the Tri-Council Policy Statement: Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans, June 2003.

Concerns or questions related to compliance with this policy should be referred to the Research Ethics Committee for consideration.
