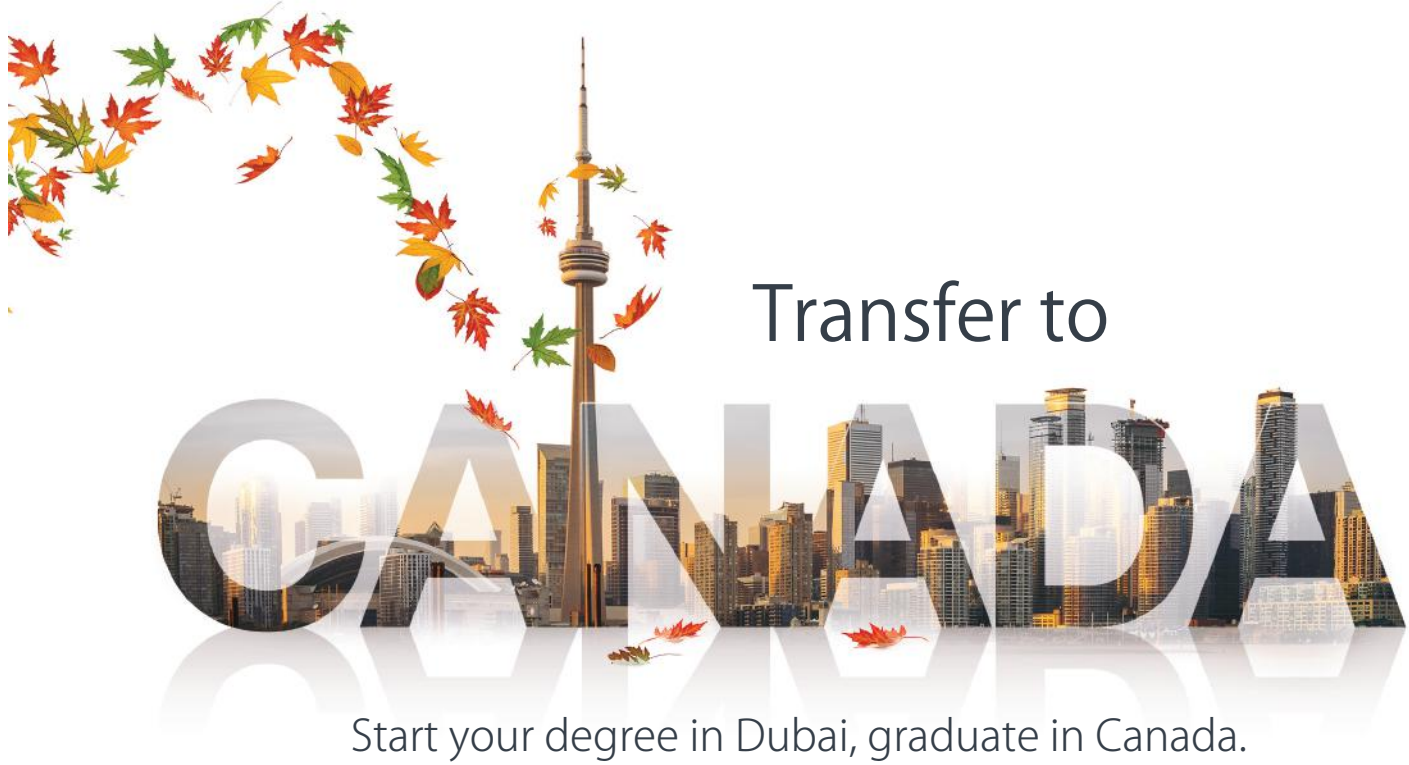

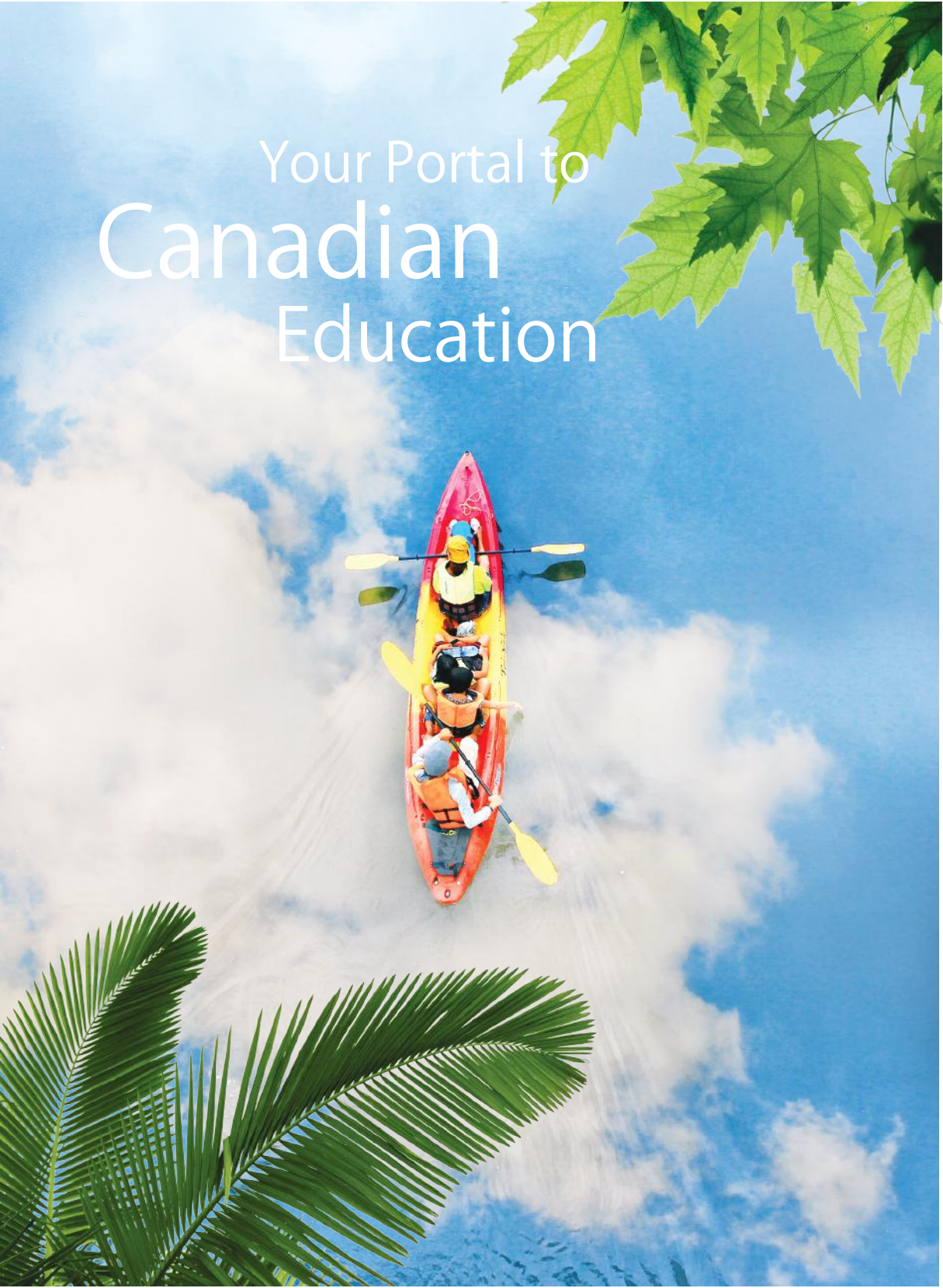

Working in Canada

By transferring to Canada to complete your degree, you become eligible for the Post Graduate Work Permit Program. This program allows a graduate with a Canadian credential to secure a work permit for up to 3 years, helping graduates qualify for permanent residency.

Here are some of the advantages in transferring to Canada:

- **Lower Cost:** If you study in Dubai for one or two years, you do not have to pay the extra housing costs and living in Canada for the first part of your education.
- **Stay with family and friends for an additional year or two before being on your own:** It is challenging for an 18 or -19year-old, fresh from high school, to transfer to a foreign university half way around the world. Studying at Canadian University Dubai for the first one or two years gives students the opportunity to gain life experience before they make the transition.
- **An easier transition to a foreign model of education:** Making the transition from one educational system to another can be difficult. We aim to make the transition easier. Our programs are based on the Canadian curriculum and our faculty are experienced with diverse learning styles and student needs. They help students adjust to different standards and approaches.
- **A proven track record and acceptance of Canadian University Dubai credits at Canadian universities:** Our University has formal agreements with a wide range of universities and degree granting colleges confirming transfer options and arrangements.

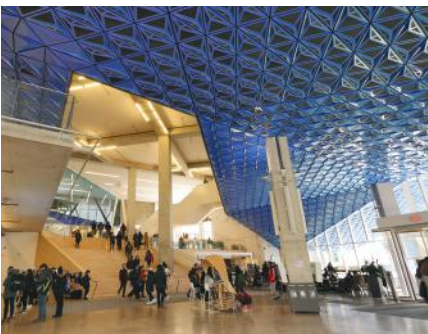

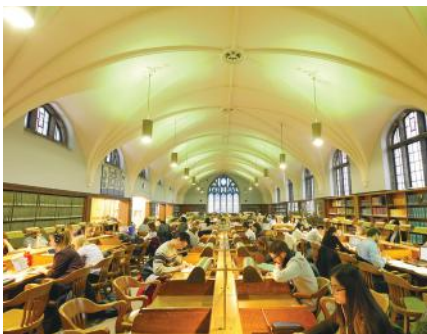

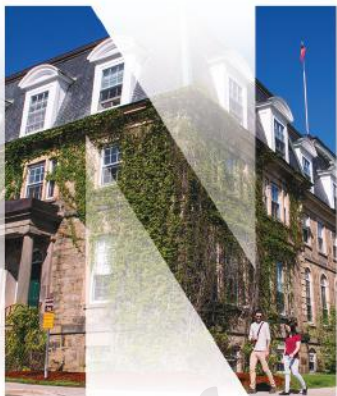
The University of New Brunswick welcomes the benefits of diversity with a long history of collaboration with international partners, welcoming international students, international development efforts, and research with an international focus.

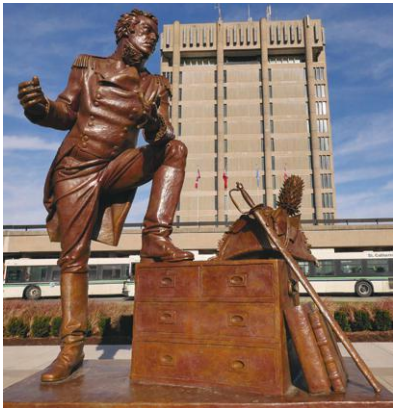
Vancouver Island University
